New Business:

-Madam Treasurer motions to discuss candidate Larry Gillis for Congressional seat, District 19

- we need to take care of the mechanics of running a campaign. The idea is to be a media driven campaign to bring attention to Libertarian issues. He has experienced in campaigns in NH. Wants to idea to identify a 3 talking point campaign to challenge Byron Donalds

- DAL desire is to make attention locally and make a name for the party.

- chair amends motion to a local seat with signature campaign. decide before June of 2024 2nd DAL.

- Josh K is running for district 77 against Tiffany Esposito and has had great community feedback. Trinity construction is potentially a supporter. Needs 600 signatures to run. Basing his campaign on his non profit that counsels single fathers. It is already collaborating with churches and community groups. Desantis authorized single non profits to be in the arena with dcs to determine better success in the family court system.

- Secretary wants to run for LAMSID and make Lehigh Acres a city, but group feels county would be a better option for decentralized movement.
